In response to your letter dated May 22, 1985, I contacted Mr. Dave Hooper. The specific drainage surrounding the gravel pile was discussed. I pointed out that the pile was located on the crest of a dirt road which presently has well established drainage along the road shoulder. The berm/ditch which was constructed around the immediate base of the pile was therefore not required for runoff diversion around the pile. After conferring with Ms. Sandy Pruitt, Mr. Hooper agreed that the small area exemption may be granted by the Division without the berm/ditch maintenance requirement.

Also, due to scheduling conflicts with mine personnel, I requested that the required May 1985, monitoring of Ivie Creek be extended through the first week of June. Mr. Hooper indicated that this would pose no problem.
