Dear Dianne:

The Division has reviewed California/Portland Cement Company's Reclamation Plan for the Hidden Valley Mine and offer the following comments for your consideration.

Page 12 and 21 - The applicant has requested a variance for retention of the road alignment along with its surface materials and cuts and fills. Since it is the applicant's intent to permanently reclaim the mine plan area, it is recommended that the road be reclaimed, also. This would include recontouring and removal of road surface materials such that a permanent vegetation cover could be re-established through final reclamation efforts.

Page 29 - On all areas with slopes greater than 10%, erosion control netting should be used to hold the alfalfa hay mulch in place.

Thank you for an opportunity to review the MRP and provide comment.
