Dear Mr. Whitehead:

This is to confirm items discussed during our telephone conversation of February 24, 1986, regarding the status of a completed reclamation plan for the Hidden Valley Coal Mine, INA/015/007, Emery County, Utah.

California Portland Cement, a Division of CalMat Co., is presently negotiating with several reclamation consulting companies to assist our staff in the writing of the Mine Reclamation Plan.

Per our telephone conversation, we requested an extension to a later date for completion of the plan. As discussed, we will make every effort to have an outline of the reclamation plan to you by the week of March 24, 1986. We propose to meet with you and your staff that week to review the outline of the reclamation plan. It is our expectation to have the completed plan prepared during the month of May. Again, we hope this fits your schedule.

It is CalMat's goal to reclaim the mine during calendar year 1986 as requested by the State of Utah, Division of Oil, Gas and Mining.
