 RE: Stipulation to Reclamation Plan, Beaver Creek Coal Company, Wildhorse Ridge, CEP/015/007, Carbon County, Utah.

Beaver Creek Coal Company has submitted a reclamation plan for the Wildhorse Ridge exploration site. On July 17, 1986 Sue Linner, Randy Harden, Dave Cline and James Leatherwood, of the Division visited the Wildhorse Ridge reclamation site. The following Stipulation (1) is based on the field site review and Beaver Creek Coal Company's June 16, 1986 submittal:

Stipulation UMC 815.15-1-JSL

1. (f) Beaver Creek Coal Company must double the two inch ripping depth to a four to six inch depth. The following fertilization recommendation must also be committed to and implemented:

Urea	30 lbs/ac	(granular)
Diammonium phosphate	40 lbs/ac	(granular)
