On September 3, 1987, state inspector Harold Sandbeck and hydrologist Tom Munson visited the Hidden Valley mine site. It was observed that a storm of major proportion had occurred at the site, damaging portions of the outslope of the road, the major reclaimed channel, and some of the reclaimed slopes. Based on the depth of flow in the main channel, the storm was greater than the design event, leaving you exempt from violations relating to the channel damage at this point in time.

The Division would like to be kept informed of your intentions regarding the repair of the site. Repair work should be completed by October 31, 1987.
