Re: Wildhorse Ridge Exploration Road: CEP/015/007, Emery County, Utah

In telephone conversations between L. P. Braxton and Gerald Vaninetti, status of reclamation on the above-captioned project was discussed. I have provided you, through Mr. Vaninetti, with copies of the Division's November 21, 1986 letter to Dan Guy, "Final Approval, Exploration Road Reclamation and Stabilization Plan, Wildhorse Ridge, Etc."

As indicated in the second to last paragraph of the letter, Beaver Creek Coal Company has adequately stabilized this exploration road. The stabilization terminated Beaver Creek's reclamation responsibility to the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining for said property. The exercise of this responsibility by Beaver Creek appears to meet conditions of your August 17, 1986 letter for stabilization with access by four-wheel drive vehicle. Nothing further is required of NEICO to close the file on these Beaver Creek Exploration activities. Future mining or exploration activity on this property of course must be preceded by acquisition of a reclamation permit.
