General Comments. Conducted a complete inspection of the Hidden Valley Mine. The records associated with the reclaimed mine were reviewed at the Salt Lake Office. The mine site has received snow and rain the past week. The only snow remaining is on the north facing slopes and it is spotty.

Signs & Markers. I.D. sign and disturbed and buffer zone markers were observed.

Diversion. Ditches, berms etc. were observed and conditions are as reported on the 12/19 & 20/94 inspection reports, i.e., all were functional and no short circuiting was observed. No significant runoff is taking place. Most of the moisture is percolating into the soil.

Other Sediment Control measures were observed which included silt fences, rock check dams and fiber dams all appeared to be functioning effectively. However, no runoff was taking place at the time of the inspection.

Support Facilities. Drift fences, gates and steel post to supplement earth and rock barriers were observed. The

Noted that Elk have moved on to the reclaimed mine site. They were observed on the mine site for several years. Historically Elk and other game animals have ventured on the reclaimed Knight Mine. Later they have been observed on the reclaimed J.B King Mine. Now they have found a winter refuge on the reclaimed Hidden Valley Mine.

It's common knowledge Elk herds have increased in Utah in recent years.
