Subject: Renewal of UPDES Permit UTG040026, Consolidation Coal-Hidden Valley

The above-referenced Utah Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (UPDES) permit will expire on April 30, 2013.

Pursuant to the Utah Wastewater Disposal Regulations, Part VIII, 8.3.1(4), you must apply for reissuance of the permit not less than 180 days prior to the expiration date. In order to apply for reissuance you must submit a completed Notice of Intent, which has been included in Part 1.B of the present permit. The Environmental Protection Agency Application (EPA Form 3510-1) is located on the Division of Water Quality's website at http://www.waterquality.utah.gov/UPDES/updes_f.htm (General Information (EPA form 1)). Please return this form and information requested to us as soon as possible, so that we can begin to process your permit for reissuance.
