
This letter is written in response to your letter of November 25, 1980 concerning the run-off control plan for Trail Mountain Coal Company.

1. The requested ditch and 48-inch culvert are to be installed in the Spring of 1981 as discussed with you earlier by letter and also by telephone. The area around the powder magazine will be handled with the use of straw filters.
2. Trail Mountain will demonstrate the adequacy of the existing pond.
3. Erosion at the inlet and outlet to the pond will be controlled by the installation of rip rap at these points.
4. The requested rip rap on the outslope of the pond will be installed.
5. A stability calculation will be done on the pond embankment, however, the Division must realize that no additional area is available to increase the side-slopes because of the proximity to Cottonwood Creek. Trail Mountain had submitted a plan to construct a new pond, however, the plan was denied because of the disturbance of additional surface. Therefore, there is no alternative to the existing pond.
6. Continued monitoring of the berm will be conducted and additional controls will be implemented if needed.

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No time limit has been established regarding the completion of these six points, therefore, the work will be done as weather permits. All requirements will be met by June 1, 1981.
