Dear Mr. Smith:

This letter is in regard to certain violations at Trail Mountain Mine as discussed with you on the telephone October 30th. The 96 inch culverts required at the road crossings are in place, however, backfilling is not complete and the old culverts have not as of yet been removed. It is requested that an extension be granted until November 21, 1980 to allow the contractor time to complete the work.

The required hydro-seeding has been completed on all disturbed areas. This will complete all the revegetation requirements at the mine site.

Only one major project remains to be completed. This is the installation of 48 inch culvert in the canyon at the drift. This project will not be started this year due to the advent of winter. Construction on this portion of the erosion control plan will be started on or before April 30, 1981, provided the weather is not too adverse to prohibit work. This will complete all required work in order to comply with current regulations.
