The Trail Mountain Coal Mine was visited on March 12, 1980 by Doug Stewart and Joe Helfrich from the Division and Larry Damrau and Tom Anderson from the Office of Surface Mining. State and federal inspectors met with Tom Rice and Dan Hanna from the Trail Mountain Mine for the purpose of terminating the following violation:

30 CFR 717.17 J(1) - Failure to divert surface runoff from the disturbed area as to prevent contribution of additional suspended solids to streamflow.

State and federal inspectors observed the following compliance measures initiated by Trail Mountain personnel:

1. Berms at both access points to the mine had been regraded and improved.
2. Catchment basins with straw dike filters had been constructed at both the east and west access areas to contain and filter runoff from the remaining portions of the permit area not affected by existing berms.

The violation was terminated.
