
This letter is in reference to our telephone conversation concerning today's inspection by Division personnel and Trail Mountain Coal Company's failure to abate Notice of Violation #8, Rule MC 717.20(b) (Failure to re-vegetate areas that are no longer used for mining), issued by the Division on June 5, 1980. Abatement time for the violation was originally set for July 7, 1980. A follow-up inspection performed on July 8, 1980, resulted in the issuance of a Cessation Order by the State inspectors for failure to abate said violation. A hearing before the Board of Oil, Gas and Mining was held on July 22, 1980, concerning this and related matters and also on September 25, 1980, regarding the proposed assessment for penalties. A Division Directive was issued on September 12, 1980, setting October 20, 1980, as the new deadline for abatement of Notice of Violation #8.

Your request for an additional extension of time for Trail Mountain Coal Company to abate said violation due to problems obtaining a hydroseeder is hereby granted by the Division for a period of two weeks only. Effective 11:30 a.m., October 22, 1980, Trail Mountain Coal Company has until 8:00 a.m., November 5, 1980, to abate Notice of Violation #8, MC 717.20(b).
