The Division of Oil, Gas and Mining, having conducted a joint State and Federal inspection of The Fetterolf Group's Trail Mountain Mine, located in Section 25, Township 17 South, Range 7 East on July 15, 1980 and finding that said operation has failed to abate said violations as referred to in Appendix A herein:

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 40-10-22(1)(c), Utah Code Annotated, the Division hereby issues an immediate Cessation Order, imposing a mandatory fine for each day of continuing violation. This Order does not require cessation of mining expressly or in practical effect. The Fetterolf Group or representatives of the Trail Mountain Mine are requested to appear before the Division and Board of Oil, Gas and Mining at 9:00 a.m., on Tuesday, July 22, 1980 in the Wildlife Resources Auditorium, 1596 West North Temple, Salt Lake City, Utah 84116 to show cause, if any there be, why this cessation order should be abated, modified or terminated.
