Trail Mountain Coal Company of Orangeville, Utah has prepared and submitted a Mining and Reclamation Plan to operate a coal mining facility northwest of Orangeville in Emery County, Utah. The mine facilities are located in Cottonwood Canyon. The project area is shown on the U.S.G.S. 7.5 minute Mahogany Point Quadrangle.
