On December 21, 1982, DOGM Field Specialist Ken Wyatt, conducted a follow-up inspection of the Natomas Trail Mountain Coal Mine. The purpose of this visit was to examine compliance work for the abatement of NOV N82-7-7-1.

At the time of this inspection, the culvert, ditch and berm were being constructed by VanWagoner Construction Company as per our meeting on December 16, 1982 (see inspection memo to coal file dated December 23, 1982). The two culverted access points had been installed as of this inspection. The ditch and berm were being constructed at this time. This pattern of drainage should promote positive surface drainage and prevent any further sedimentation violations for Natomas Trail Mountain Coal Company.

The debris and trash were still present in the sedimentation pond as of this inspection. This material should be removed as soon as possible. Allen Childs of Natomas Trail Mountain Coal Company agreed to have this material removed before the January inspection. No other compliance problems were observed at this time.
