On Thursday, August 12, 1982, a partial inspection of the above-mentioned minesite was conducted by Ken Wyatt and Barton Kale of the Division. They were accompanied by Glade Hone of Natomas Trail Mtn. Coal Company. The purpose of this inspection was to examine paperwork in relation to the upcoming undisturbed drainage bypass culvert to be installed in Cottonwood Creek this construction season.

NOV #82-7-5-1 was issued on July 15, 1982. Mr. King had stated that Natomas plans to install this bypass culvert in an effort to abate this violation (see Memo to Coal File dated August 11, 1982). At the time of this inspection, it was requested that a Purchase Order (PO) be shown to this inspector to verify that the culverting had been purchased for this installation. Also, a contractor's bid was requested to verify that this work was indeed going to be conducted. A PO, #4159, dated August 12, 1982 and a contractor's bid was observed. These forms were verified on the following day during phone calls to Pacific Corrugated Pipe Company in Lehi, Utah, and Nielson Contractors of Huntington, Utah.

Due to the fact that Natomas is working to get this culvert installed, the abatement deadline for this NOV was again extended until August 31, 1982. This additional time should allow for Natomas to coordinate culvert delivery and coordination of the contractor's schedule.

The inlet to the sediment pond was still blocked due to coal-like material. Mr. Hone was informed that this area should be maintained to provide a direct conveyance of disturbed area runoff into the sediment pond. Mr. Hone stated that Dan Cox of Orangeville was to re-establish this inlet that day. NAOC #82-7-3-1 was given to insure that this work was done. During future inspections, no allowance will be given for failure to maintain sediment control structures as designed.
