In response to your September 13, 1982 letter, the Division feels that the areas of concern which were mentioned in the December 7, 1981 letter from DOGM have been satisfactorily addressed by Natomas Trail Mountain Coal Company.

With regards to the August 26, 1982 letter, the Division would like a description of the type of temporary trash rack that will be used as requested in Condition 3C. The Division requests a response to this item within 10 days of receipt of this letter.

The Division suggests that the size of the riprap to be placed at the intake of the culvert be a minimum of one foot in diameter to withstand velocities generated during spring runoff.
