A review team field trip to the Natomas Trail Mountain Mine was taken on Thursday, January 20, 1983. The team includes Tom Munson, Doug Maier, Dave Darby (co-lead), Steve Cox, Everett Hooper and Pamela Grubaugh-Littig (lead). An overview tour of the "confined" facilities was led by Allen Childs, the environmental coordinator and mine engineer. The new sediment pond structure was observed. It is almost complete, except for the inlet. The 48-inch bypass culvert was also observed. Allen Childs stated that the contract has been awarded for the construction of the culvert under the loadout. Construction will begin when the weather permits.

Tom Munson, Doug Maier, and Pamela Grubaugh-Littig saw the sump used underground. The ACR is scheduled to be complete by February 11, 1983.
