The cross-sections received by the Divisions on December 9, 1983 are insufficient to abate the Notice of Violation N83-4-13-1.

The following information is required before an abatement determination can be made:

1. A map showing the locations of the stream channel diversions, the cross-section reference points and the borrow sites from which the fill material was obtained.
2. Submit size of rip-rap used and calculations that substantiate its ability to withstand velocities generated by a 25 year flood event. Indicate on the map the lateral extent of the areas that were ripped.
