Dear Mr. Childs:

The Division has reviewed your submittal of March 7, 1983 regarding abatement of Violation N82-7-7-1. I have decided to approve these actions if the following stipulations are adhered to:

1. These plans must be implemented within 60 days.
2. A detailed drainage control map showing all drainage improvements on site must be drafted and submitted to the Division in 60 days. This map should include both undisturbed and disturbed area drainages.
3. Proper maintenance of drainage control has been a problem in the past due to interference of equipment and supplies within the area of the drainage control structures. Therefore, it is requested that Natomas submit a plan to provide protection of the new drainage structure from on-site equipment use and supply storage. Whether it is in the form of fencing or large obstructions (boulders, etc.), the round metal culvert must be protected so that it is not rendered ineffective. This information must be provided before implementation of the plan. Natomas has suggested that it will use a water hose to periodically flush the culvert, if necessary. Natomas must, therefore, state that it has these facilities available on-site and readily available for periodic maintenance.
