Dear Mr. Childs:

The abatement response to NOV N82-7-7-1 which you have submitted to the Division for review is inadequate. The Division would like to see more detailed cross-sections of the drainage ditch, berm and also what structures are being used to divert flow into the two culverts. During our field meeting, there was discussion of putting catchment boxes in front of the culverts and there was no mention of these in the plans we received. We need cross-sections with dimensions for the berm, the fill above the culverts, drainage ditch and the drop boxes or similar structures, if they were included in your design.

Please send this information to the Division as soon as possible so we can review your proposed plan and hopefully issue a formal approval for your plans.
