RE: Temporary Cessation, Trail Mountain Mine, ACT/015/009, #2 and #13, Emery County, Utah

This is to advise you of your obligations required under UMC 817.131, Temporary Cessation of Operations. Temporary abandonment does not "relieve a person of his or her obligation to comply with any provisions of the approved permit."

In addition, the notice "shall include a statement of the exact number of surface acres and the horizontal and vertical extent of subsurface strata which have been in the permit area prior to cessation or abandonment, the extent and kind of reclamation of surface area which will have been accomplished, and identification of the backfilling, regrading, revegetation, environmental monitoring, underground opening closures and water treatment activities that will continue during the temporary cessation."

Please make sure that the Division is notified as soon as possible in this matter.
