Dear Mr. Childs:

RE: Permit Review Procedures for New Lease Application, Trail Mountain Coal Company, Trail Mountain Mine, ACT/015/009, #2, Emery County, Utah

This letter will serve to summarize the procedures by which your Company's anticipated new lease application must be reviewed in order to obtain a permit under the permanent program. The Division understands that Trail Mountain currently holds this new lease (federal), contiguous to the present permit area. As this area is not contained within the current permit area, your submittal for permitting mining within the new lease must be a new permit application. After the review and approval of the application, the original permit area and the newly permitted area will be combined into a new, comprehensive permit area.

Enclosed is a flow chart which demonstrates the steps entailed in the review of a new permit application (PAP). This anticipated submittal will not involve direct disturbance of additional areas and, therefore, many of the UMC 782, 783 and 784 regulations which must be addressed in a PAP can be cross-referenced to the original, approved permit. However, some regulatory requirements will necessitate the submittal of additional information, such as additional legal and financial (UMC 782), hydrologic and geologic (UMC 783.13-.15), operational and subsidence related information (UMC 784). As this anticipated PAP involves federal coal, 13 copies of the PAP must be submitted to the Division for distribution to pertinent state and federal agencies.




