Dear Dr. Nielson:

The Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement has received the January 6, 1986 submission from Diamond Shamrock Coal Company for an incidental boundary revision to add 1.7 acres to the approved area to be mined. This entire amendment area is within Federal coal lease U-082996 which is in the approved permit area for the Trail Mountain mine. The Bureau of Land Management approved the Resource Recovery and Protection Plan (R2P2) on May 19, 1986 for the Track II revision now being processed by OSMRE. The proposed mining on the incidental boundary will follow the R2P2 required for the Track II permit revision.

Because the incidental boundary revision mainly constitutes a minor change in the approved R2P2 for the Trail Mountain mine and no surface disturbance is proposed, OSMRE concurs with DOGM's approval of the incidental boundary revision as specified in your letter of January 29, 1987.
