I reviewed the Permit Transfer Package submitted by Beaver Creek Coal Company dated September 24, 1987. I checked for its adequacy according to regulation UMC 788.18. The bond is in effect (with two minor details that will be ridered to the bond, see letter to Mickey Love from me dated October 1, 1987).

All of the applicable regulations were addressed adequately with the exception of 782.17 (Permit Term Information). The applicant didn't clearly state the anticipated or actual starting and termination date of each phase of the underground coal mining activities. It is assumed that the original permit issuance date sets the schedule for mid-term reviews, etc.

The applicant should include information regarding the permit term dates that will be involved at this mine for the life of mine.
