Dear Mr. Braxton;

Enclosed for your review and approval, you will find Trail Mountain's permit application package to drill a culinary "deep" water well at the Trail Mountain Mine site, 12 miles west of Orangeville, Utah.

It is proposed by Trail Mountain that in lieu of diverting 17.6 acre-feet of water from Cottonwood Creek, that this same quantity of water be diverted from a 12 inch diameter well 300-350 feet deep located at a point north 3350 feet and east 1952 feet from the SW corner of Section 25, T17S, R6E, SLB&M. The water well will be used on an annual basis for the domestic requirements of 43 people, dust suppression and other industrial uses in conjunction with the Trail Mountain Mine operations.
