RE: Trail Mountain Mine Exploration Plan, Trail Mountain Coal Company, Trail Mountain Mine, ACT/015/009, Folder #2, Emery County, Utah

The operator's application for an exploration permit is not complete. The following items need to be addressed:

1. Figure 2 must reflect the new drill hole location as of 5/14/87. Additionally, Figure 2 must contain an accurate and complete map legend.
2. A current and site-specific cultural resource survey should be present in the application.
3. The name and address of the surface owner(s) should be in the Identification of Interest section.
4. The drilling plan calls for a biodegradable air/foam drilling fluid. However, the operator may have to utilize drilling mud. If mud is used, the operator must commit to a biodegradable mud.
