Trail Mountain Mine, ACT/015/009, Folder #2, Emery County, Utah

The Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining (Division) has granted approval and issued a revised five-year mining permit to Trail Mountain Coal Company. The Division has determined that the permit application is technically complete and demonstrates compliance with all the "Regulations Pertaining to Surface Effects of Underground Coal Mining Activities, Final Rules of the Utah Board and Division of Oil, Gas and Mining" promulgated under the Utah Coal Mining Reclamation Act (Utah Code Annotated 1953, Section 40-10-1 et seq).

Notice is hereby given to all appropriate agencies and individuals having jurisdiction over, or an interest in the area of the proposed operations, pursuant to UMC 786.23(d)(e)(f), that a permit has been issued to said permittee.

This permit authorizes the permittee, Trail Mountain Coal Company, to conduct underground coal mining activities and operations connected with the underground mining on the described lands within the permit area at the Trail Mountain Mine, situated in the state of Utah, county of Emery, subject to the terms of the lease(s), the approved mining and reclamation plan, this permit and all applicable laws and regulations. The lands included in this permit are described as follows:

Township 17 South, Range 6 East, SLBM

Section 25: S1/2 NW1/4, W1/2 SW1/4, W1/2 E1/2 SW1/4, SW1/4 SE1/4,
E1/2 E1/2 SW1/4

Begin at point of SW Corner of NW1/4 SE1/4, thence North 160 Rods, thence East 44 Rods to Center of Cottonwood Creek, Southward along creek to a point 76 Rods east of the beginning, thence west 76 Rods to the Point of Beginning.
