The recent enactment of the Cooperative Agreement between the Office of Surface Mining and the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining obviates the need for separate permits by both agencies. In the new capacity, the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining will assume all of the delegable federal permitting responsibilities. On this basis, it is desirable to dissolve the existing federal permits with the special permit conditions to be included in the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining permit.

For the Trail Mountain Mine, the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining will assume responsibility for special federal permit conditions, and will incorporate these conditions into the Utah permit as revised for the Tract 2 area.
