Dear Ms. Grubaugh-Littig:

On August 13, 1990, we received a copy of Beaver Creek Coal Company's Permit Application Package (PAP) for the addition of Federal lease U-64375 to the Trail Mountain No. 9 Mine permit. We have reviewed the plan for post-mining land uses and protection of nonmineral resources for the small portion of public land outside the Manti-LaSal National Forest. We have no concerns or recommendations concerning nonmineral resources for the public lands under the BLM's jurisdiction for the permit addition.

We have also reviewed the PAP concerning the resource recovery and protection plan (R2P2). Our technical review of the R2P2 has identified some deficiencies. The BLM will contact Beaver Creek directly to correct these deficiencies. We will send copies of all pertinent correspondence.
