Re: Underground Water Monitoring Point TM-3, Trail Mountain #9 Mine, Mountain Coal Company, ACT/015/009, Folder #3, Emery County, Utah

The request to eliminate the drilling of the underground monitoring well TM-3 is denied. Data from water monitoring point TM-3 will be used to compare data from existing wells as well as data from the approved future surface well. Correlation of data from all wells will aid in the understanding the groundwater system and the effects of coal mining on that system in the area of the Trail Mountain #9 Mine. Additionally, TM-3 is a replacement of a lost monitoring point and as such should not be eliminated.
