Dear Mr. Jorgensen,

Energy West Mining Co., a subsidiary of PacifiCorp, will be conducting an exploration drilling program on Trail Mountain during August through October of this year. We will require water for the drilling of the exploration drill holes and plan to obtain that water from two springs on Trail Mountain. These springs are identified as 28-1P located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 28 Township 17 S. Range 6 E. and 18-2-1 located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 2 Township 18 S. Range 6 E.

We will require approximately 240,000 gallons (< 1 acre foot) for the total project. We are in the process of establishing a temporary point of diversion at the spring sites with the State Engineers Office. We will keep a record of the amount of water taken from these springs and give it to you, so you can apply this usage to our existing water shares.
