All replacement pages are identified with a revision date of 2/5/93.


**This letter also serves to update my letter of November 24, 1992, regarding Notification of Temporary Cessation of Operations at the Trail Mountain Mine. Underground rehabilitation work is expected to increase in the near future. Surface activities associated with underground rehabilitation will involve materials and underground development waste storage and staging activities. During rehabilitation, it may be necessary to store materials in all available areas of the mine yard, including the haul road area.**

**This letter constitutes a request for approval to store materials within the haul road area during the rehabilitation period. Placement of materials will be done in such manner as to not impede the approved surface drainage patterns. Surface compliance maintenance activities will continue during the rehabilitation period. Rehabilitation is expected to continue into the third quarter of 1993.**
