## SYNOPSIS

The permittee submitted this amendment for Division approval on April 21, 1993. The amendment allows for the construction of a storage shed.

## ANALYSIS

The storage shed is to be built in the main storage area between the substation and the office/shop complex. It will be built of structural steel and covered with a corrugated aluminum shell. The shed will be L-shaped, one leg of the L being 42 feet long by 15 feet wide and the other leg being 33 feet long by 8 feet wide. In the present submittal, the shed has been added to the Surface Facilities Map, Figure 3-1.

The permittee has estimated the total cost of removing the storage shed to be about \$730. This cost has been added to the overall reclamation cost estimate. This brings the reclamation cost estimate from \$688,720 to a total of \$690,329, which total is escalated at a rate of 6.78% per year over 10 years. Thus, at \$700,000, the present reclamation bond is still more than adequate to cover the additional cost of removing the storage shed.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that this amendment be approved and that construction of the storage shed be allowed to proceed. At my recommendation, the permittee was notified of this approval by Hugh Klein during an April 29, 1993 inspection of the Trail Mountain site.
