





Dear Mr. Payne:

PacifiCorp's emergency helicopter exploration plan for up to five drill holes on Federal coal lease U-06039 is approved as submitted, subject to the following conditions:

1. All the enclosed Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Drilling Stipulations (Enclosure 1) will be followed.
2. The enclosed Forest Service Special Stipulations (Enclosure 2) will be followed.
3. We will require that the present lease bond on Federal coal lease U-06039 be increased by \$25,000 to cover plugging procedures, final abandonment and reclamation. No work on this project is to begin until a bond is in place.
4. A road-use permit for Forest Service Development Roads must be obtained before any work begins.
