At present, this mine is not producing coal. Surface and underground facilities are being constructed and modified to accommodate longwall mining. Mining is expected to resume in 1995.

4. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE

a) **Diversions**--The main diversion and all culverts were observed. All were found to be clean and in good repair. Since equipment and parts are being stored along the outer edge of the main facilities area, the permittee is advised to take special care not to block the main diversion.

b) **Sediment Ponds and Impoundments**--The sediment pond contained very little water and had not discharged since the last inspection. Sediment pond embankments are in good condition.

c) **Other Sediment Control Measures**--The silt fences on the topsoil stockpile, in the BTCA at the upper end of the site, and in the BTCA below the sediment pond were examined and found to be in good condition.

16. ROADS

a) **Construction/Maintenance/Surfacing**--All roads and pads have been surfaced with gravel. The gravel is working very well to prevent erosion and fugitive dust. All road and pad surfaces were hard and dry and in good condition.
