The aforementioned amendment is approved. The approval is based on the information you submitted together with the regulatory findings cited below.

Followup Action By Permittee

Within 30 days after this project is completed, please submit:

- (1) Copies of a certified updated surface facilities map to the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining (DOGM) Price Field Office. We in turn will make the appropriate distribution to responsible parties including our DOGM Salt Lake Office, (Plate 3-1 & 7-5), and
- (2) Update your SPC plan to include the used oil tank that is located in the servicing pit. You need not send us a copy of this plan. It will be reviewed in conjunction with our mine inspection.

Project Description

In summary, the key features of this project are as follows:

ENLARGING SHOP BUILDING. The addition is 52' long, 33' wide and the height will be the same as the existing building. With the addition, the building, when completed, will have a rectangular instead of an octagon configuration. A slotted drain contiguous to the existing building will be decommissioned and/or removed. The drainage from the area will be sheet flow. An equipment servicing pit and used oil container is included in the building addition. This installation is necessary to improve and better control materials when equipment is serviced. A used oil tank will be located in the pit.

Findings

- (1) The applicant submitted a complete and accurate amendment application.
- (2) DOGM PERMIT STATUS. The addition lies within the current permit.
- (3) ACTIVE MINE. The area is included in an active approved coal mining and reclamation operation is within the existing disturbed area.
- (4) LAND STATUS. The land is patented land owned by PacifiCorp.
- (5) OTHER APPROVAL. The addition lies within 100' of Emery County Road #57. The permittee has obtained the approval of Emery County as related to necessary approvals required by R645-103-234 and Emery County Building Department. (Copy Attached).
- (6) IMPACTS. The project does not have any material adverse impacts to hydrologic balance, nor does it involve any existing critical habitat.
- (7) RECLAMATION AND BONDING. The reclamation plan, as currently approved, is accurate. The reclamation costs have been updated. Bonding cost tables 3-4 and 3-5 have been updated and the increases are reflected by the shaded costs. The area being redisturbed and reclamation costs associated therewith, have heretofore, been bonded and approved by the Division. Demolition of the building addition is \$3088.00. The updated total reclamation cost is \$837,244.00. The current bond totals \$1,000,000.00.

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- (8) RECORD UPDATE. The project as submitted and evaluated by the undersigned does not require an update of the Division Technical Analysis pertaining to the Trail Mountain Mine. The MRP at our office will be updated when the followup items are submitted by the permittee.


