Dear Mr. Payne:

The Division recently reviewed the Mining and Reclamation Plan for the Trail Mtn. Mine as part of the permit renewal process. While your plan is considered complete and accurate for allowing the renewal to occur, there are some areas that need additional work. These areas deal primarily with the general nature of the reference citations. References in Chapter 3, Sections 3.4.3.1 and 3.4.3.4 are too broad and must be made more definitive (don't just refer to Chapter 7). References to Chapter 7 of the MRP must give, at a minimum the sections within the chapter, and Annual Hydrologic Reports should be more specific as to which years and from which data the conclusions are made.

In order to make your plan a more complete document please submit a response which will address the reference issues by no later than March 24, 1995.
