

Due to the required time frame for advertising the Forest Service concerns, and the fact the closing date was on February 8, 1997, your request for additional copies on February 10, 1997 cannot be met. Environmental Engineering concerns were that a change could be initiated by the Forest Service from public comments, therefore further work towards finishing the remaining improvements was halted. If additional changes did occur from public comments then all finishing touches could be completed together. Nothing has been received on any required changes from the Forest Service, but there are several items that need to be improved on the maps and will require time to accomplish. In addition the time required to print that many drawings is lengthy. Therefore a 45 day extension is requested.

When the additional seven copies of the complete permit change can be accomplished, they will be sent or delivered to your office.
