General Comments. Walked over the mine site. It was snowing at the start, raining at the end and a strong down canyon wind was blowing throughout the field inspection. The snow was melting as soon as it hit the ground. However, the upper elevations were well dusted with snow and the mountains when observable were white and snow covered.

The mine site was muddy because of the rain and snow. No runoff was observed except for the undisturbed main Cottonwood drainage and a small amount of runoff in the concrete disturbed ditch that reports to the sediment pond.

Diversion. Ditches, culverts and berms were observed and are in compliance with performance standards. Sediment Pond. The sediment pond contained runoff and the water level was <sup>above</sup> the oil skimmer and about a foot below the road ditch culvert.

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Should the rainy weather/wash down continue, it won't be long before the pond will have to be dewatered and discharge sampled Coal Mine Waste. No temporary storage of coal mine waste was observed at the mine. NonCoal Mine Waste. Mr. Oakley has been actively pursuing a spring cleanup. His initial proposal was to utilize summer college employees to perform the spring cleanup. However, being a union mine, this may be inimical to unions point of view. Therefore, the cleanup will be completed during mine vacation period, the first part of July.

Roads. Roads were graded and surfaced. No standing water was observed on any of the roads.
