General Comments. Responding to Paul Grumbach hitting request to validate permit area, Dennis Oakley just completed a review of this permit area. His data shows the following:

Total Area In Acres	3538 ⁹⁸
Federal	3405 ⁹⁸
Non-Federal	53 ⁵⁰

Field. Walked over the mine site and no problems were noted.

Dimensions. All ditches were open. The only dimension with runoff, other than Cottonwood Creek, was the tipple wash down dimension system.

The temporary pond discharge line was still in place. The pond was cleaned early in December. The mine officials advised me that the pipe has been removed.

Sediment Pond. Sediment pond contained runoff, was not discharging and was well below the decant level.

Non-Coal Waste. Non-coal waste was confined to the designated storage area. Mentioned to the surface foreman the parking lot was ship/shape.
