

PacificCorp, by and through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Energy West Mining Company (Energy West) as mine operator, hereby submits an application for a permit renewal of the Trail Mountain Mine for the purposes of conducting mining and reclamation activities. Currently, the Trail Mountain is in temporary suspension and has been in this condition since May, 2003. There are no plans to restart the mine in the near future. The permit area encompasses all or portions of Section 25, 26, 27, 24, and 28 of T12S, R6E, S10M; Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30 of T12S, R7E, S10M. The permit area is approximately 3,592 acres with a disturbed acreage equaling 10,580 acres.
