The Trail Mountain Mine and Waste Rock Site facilities have been sold by PacifiCorp to Fossil Rock Resources, LLC. The mine and associated facilities have been renamed the Fossil Rock Mine under the new ownership. In the near future, the permit documents where possible will be corrected to reflect the new name of the mine facilities. Historic information will retain the name of the permittee at the time of the event. 


