**1. Permits, Change, Transfer, Renewal, Sale**

1. At the time of the inspection the Trail Mountain Mine was still owned by PacifiCorp. The Cottonwood waste rock site has been fully transferred from the Cottonwood-Wilberg mine to the Trail Mountain mine.

**4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions**

All ditches and culverts were in good order. A drop pipe next to a gate was covered with a couple inches of sediment and Mr. Oakley cleaned it off so it is functioning properly. The runoff reporting to this covered drop pipe was still contained by a berm and ditch network and was able to report to the sediment pond.

**4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments**

The UPDES permit # UT0023728 has added the Cottonwood Waste Rock outfall as point 003. The final copy of the permit is almost published. The Pond was inspected on March 6, 2015 and had a sediment volume of 0.26 A.F. This is less than the 60% clean-out volume of 0.282 A.F. The DMR states no discharge occurred for 001 and 002 from January through March.

**4.d Hydrologic Balance: Water Monitoring**

The water monitoring data has been submitted for the second quarter of 2015.

**5. Explosives**

There are no explosives stored on site.

**21. Bonding and Insurance**

The Permittee has increased the bond under Task ID #4790 to cover the addition of the Cottonwood waste rock site. The bond is now at \$1,154,00.00. The Permittee is covered under liability insurance from 10-1-2014 through 10-1-2015.
