

ADMINISTRATIVE OVERVIEW

PROPOSAL

The Trail Mountain Mine and Waste Rock Site facilities have been sold by PacifiCorp to Fossil Rock Resources, LLC. The mine and associated facilities have been renamed Fossil Rock Mine under the new ownership.

BACKGROUND

The Trail Mountain Mine is located on the eastern edge of the Wasatch Plateau Coal Field, approximately 12 miles west of Orangeville, Utah. Mining at or near the Trail Mountain Mine began in 1898 and a large-scale operation started in 1909. Mining continued until 1967 when the mine was shut down for ten years. The mine was re-opened in 1977 and has had several owners since then. The Trail Mountain Mine was purchased from Arco Coal in 1992 by PacifiCorp and has been operated by Energy West Company, a wholly owned subsidiary of PacifiCorp.

Through a sales agreement dated June 7, 2015 with PacifiCorp, an Oregon Corporation, Bowie Resources Partners purchased the Trail Mountain Mine and Waste Rock Site facility. In the future the Trail Mountain will be referred to as the Fossil Rock Mine. The Fossil Rock Mine is owned by Fossil Rock Resources, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, which is wholly owned by Canyon Fuel Company, LLC.

PUBLIC NOTICE

The applicant published notice for the permit transfer on September 8, 2015 in the Sun Advocate. No comments, objections, or requests for informal conference were received by the Division during the 30-day comment period.

AVS CHECK

A review of the AVS system was conducted on September 8, 2015 and October 5, 2015. The system showed that there were no outstanding violations for PacifiCorp or Fossil Rock Resources, LLC. Fossil Rock Resources, LLC is clear to receive a permit.

RECOMMENDATION

The Division made the decision to approve the permit transfer on the fact that 1) The terms and conditions of the existing permit are being satisfactorily met; 2) The present coal mining and reclamation operations are in compliance with the environmental protection standards of the State Program; 3) The transfer does not substantially jeopardize the operator's continuing ability to comply with the State Program on existing permit areas; and 4) The operator has provided evidence of having liability insurance and a performance bond which will be in effect for the operation and will continue in full force and effect.

Sec. 1 STATUTES AND REGULATIONS - This permit is issued pursuant to the Utah Coal Mining and Reclamation Act of 1979, Utah Code Annotated (UCA) 40-10-1 et seq, hereafter referred to as the Act.

This legal description is for the permit area of the Fossil Rock Mine, which is approximately 3,564.83 acres. The permittee is authorized to conduct coal mining and reclamation operations on the foregoing described property subject to the conditions of all applicable conditions, laws and regulations.

Sec. 3 COMPLIANCE - The permittee will comply with the terms and conditions of the permit, all applicable performance standards and requirements of the State Program.

- Sec. 4 PERMIT TERM** - This permit expires on February 21, 2020.
- Sec. 5 ASSIGNMENT OF PERMIT RIGHTS** - The permit rights may not be transferred, assigned or sold without the prior written approval of the Division Director. Transfer, assignment or sale of permit rights must be done in accordance with applicable regulations, including but not limited to 30 CFR 740.13{e} and R645-303-300.
- Sec. 6 RIGHT OF ENTRY** - The permittee shall allow the authorized representative of the Division, including but not limited to inspectors, and representatives of the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSM), without advance notice or a search warrant, upon presentation of appropriate credentials, and without delay to:
- (a) have the rights of entry provided for in 30 CFR 840.12, R645-400-220, 30 CFR 842.13 and R645-400-110;
 - (b) be accompanied by private persons for the purpose of conducting an inspection in accordance with R645-400-100 and R645-400-200 when the inspection is in response to an alleged violation reported to the Division by the private person.
- Sec. 7 SCOPE OF OPERATIONS** - The permittee shall conduct coal mining and reclamation operations only on those lands specifically designated as within the permit area on the maps submitted in the approved plan and approved for the term of the permit and which are subject to the performance bond.
- Sec. 8 ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS** - The permittee shall take all possible steps to minimize any adverse impact to the environment or public health and safety resulting from noncompliance with any term or condition of the permit, including, but not limited to:
- (a) Any accelerated or additional monitoring necessary to determine the nature and extent of noncompliance and the results of the noncompliance;
 - (b) immediate implementation of measures necessary to comply; and
 - (c) warning, as soon as possible after learning of such noncompliance, any person whose health and safety is in imminent danger due to the noncompliance.
- Sec. 9 DISPOSAL OF POLLUTANTS** - The permittee shall dispose of solids, sludge, filter backwash or pollutants in the course of treatment or control of waters or emissions to the air in the manner required by the approved Utah State Program and the Federal Lands Program which prevents violation of any applicable state or federal law.
- Sec. 10 CONDUCT OF OPERATIONS** - The permittee shall conduct its operations:

- (a) in accordance with the terms of the permit to prevent significant, imminent environmental harm to the health and safety of the public; and
- (b) utilizing methods specified as conditions of the permit by the Division in approving alternative methods of compliance with the performance standards of the Act, the approved Utah State Program and the Federal Lands Program.

- Sec. 11 EXISTING STRUCTURES** - As applicable, the permittee will comply with R645-301 and R645-302 for compliance, modification, or abandonment of existing structures.
- Sec. 12 RECLAMATION FEE PAYMENTS** - The operator shall pay all reclamation fees required by 30 CFR Part 870 for coal produced under the permit, for sale, transfer or use.
- Sec. 13 AUTHORIZED AGENT** - The permittee shall provide the names, addresses and telephone numbers of persons responsible for operations under the permit to whom notices and orders are to be delivered.
- Sec. 14 COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS** - The permittee shall comply with the provisions of the Water Pollution Control Act (33 USC 1151 et seq,) and the Clean Air Act (42 USC 7401 et seq), UCA 26-11-1 et seq, and UCA 26-13-1 et seq.
- Sec. 15 PERMIT RENEWAL** - Upon expiration, this permit may be renewed for areas within the boundaries of the existing permit in accordance with the Act, the approved Utah State Program and the Federal Lands Program.
- Sec. 16 CULTURAL RESOURCES** - If during the course of mining operations, previously unidentified cultural resources are discovered, the permittee shall ensure that the site(s) is not disturbed and shall notify the Division. The Division, after coordination with OSM, shall inform the permittee of necessary actions required. The permittee shall implement the mitigation measures required by The Division within the time frame specified by The Division.
- Sec. 17 APPEALS** - The permittee shall have the right to appeal as provided for under R645-300-200.
- Sec. 18 SPECIAL CONDITIONS** - There are special conditions associated with this permit, as described in Attachment A.

The above conditions (Secs. 1-18) are also imposed upon the permittee's agents and employees. The failure or refusal of any of these persons to comply with these conditions shall be deemed a failure of the permittee to comply with the terms of this permit and the lease. The permittee shall require his agents, contractors and subcontractors involved in activities concerning this permit to include these conditions in the contracts between and among them. These conditions may be revised or amended, in writing, by the mutual consent of the Division and the permittee at any time to adjust to changed conditions or to correct an oversight. The Division may amend these conditions at any time without the consent of the permittee in order to make them consistent with any federal or state statutes and any regulations.

SPECIAL CONDITION

1. Fossil Rock Resources, LLC will submit water quality data for the Fossil Rock Mine in an electronic format through the Electronic Data Input web site, <http://linux1.ogm.utah.gov/cgi-bin/appx-ogm.cgi>.
2. If during entry development, sustained quantities of groundwater are encountered which are greater than 5 gpm from a single source in an individual entry, and which continue after operational activities progress beyond the area of groundwater production, Fossil Rock Resources, LLC must monitor these flows for quality and quantity under the approved monitoring plan. If significant quantities of groundwater which issues from a fault zone are encountered, Fossil Rock Resources, LLC will: quantify the volume, sample for water quality according to the approved monitoring plan (baseline parameters for the two year period), conduct isotopic sampling using a systematic approach (phase 1: tritium analysis, phase 2: depending on the results of the tritium sampling, perform carbon age dating). Parameters analyzed are those listed in the "DOGGM Guidelines for Groundwater Quality."


