Dear Mr. O'Conner:

We have received the Consolidation Coal letter of July 24, 1978, and the EPA Public Notice of October 10, 1978 regarding two new discharge points at the Emery Mine. As indicated in our phone conversations of October 4 and 27, we need additional information on the sedimentation and storage tank overflow before construction begins and before we can certify this permit.

This information should include an engineering report, design criteria, flood protection provisions, expected effluent TDS and TSS concentrations, flow rates and detailed plans and specifications. The plans should show the collection ditches, the piping, sedimentation pond, influent and effluent structures, etc. State standards for design and treatment are included in Part III of the enclosed Wastewater Disposal Regulations. Sections 1, 2 and 87-91 may be particularly appropriate to your project.

When satisfactory plans are approved by this office, we will complete our certification of the discharge permit.
