A telephone conversation was held on March 30th 1978 with Mr. John Kaufman of Consol's Denver office relative to the Division's requirements for reclamation of a sanitary landfill adjacent to this mine. Mr. Kaufman asked if a landfill used to dispose of solid waste, ie. timbers, empty oil drums, and other debris, from the mining operation would be considered as a part of the mining operation if the landfill were constructed and regulated by the Utah State Division of Health or the EPA Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA).

In line with the direction given the Division in the Utah Mined Land Reclamation Act to eliminate duplication of efforts, he was told that the landfill would not be considered as a part of the mining operation.

By copying this memo to the various individuals from involved agencies, it will serve as notice to them and invite their dissenting opinions on this decision if any exist.
