These sites were visited by Mary Ann Wright on February 4, 1980 in conjunction with Clark Johnson, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Larry Dalton, Division of Wildlife Resources, and Steve Dole of Consol for the purpose of completing the wildlife consultation.

The following items were discussed:

1. The need for a 6-8 day raptor survey 1 Km. from all surface activities.
2. The need for a prairie dog colony survey and mapping for all areas to be disturbed.
3. The need for basic physical stream data collection for any streams to be disturbed.
4. It was decided that adjacent areas for purposes of wildlife study were not needed at these sites due to the nature of the mine plan having a buffer zone built into the area.
5. Mr. Johnson expressed concern for looking for birds of high federal interest.
6. Mr. Dalton requested that any snake dens located during any surveys be reported.
7. Mr. Dalton and Mr. Johnson stated that they knew the area to be of limited wildlife use by typical desert species including yearlong range for mule deer. They felt that present data literature would suffice for remaining wildlife information.
8. Mr. Dalton has sent this Division a written response to the consultation.
