On October 28, 1981, Lynn Kunzler, Ev Hooper, and Sally Kefer of the Division met with Mary Jo Ormiston, Carl Muha, Rick Williamson and Dean Bray of Consolidation Coal Company at the Emery Deep Mine.

After discussing potential problems and concerns with the review of their MRP, we toured the locations of the proposed prep plant, slurry ponds, and waste disposal areas, with particular interest in the soils and vegetation.

There was no vegetation sampling done in the areas of the proposed disturbance. However, after inspecting these areas and comparing them with the sampling locations and reference areas for the vegetation types that would be affected, it was determined that vegetation types were very homogenous over the area, and that the reference areas and the sample areas for the baseline data were representative of the proposed disturbance area and could be used for the revegetation standards without additional sampling.
