The Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining has completed a cursory review of the Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) and amendments submitted by Consolidation Coal Company for the preparation plant and loadout facility. The permit to be issued is considered a modification to the existing State of Utah permit ACT/015/015. This Division has determined the plan to be apparently complete. In compliance with Section UMC 786.11(b) and (c) of the Utah Coal Mining Reclamation Act (UCA, Section 40-10-1 et seq), notice is hereby given to all appropriate agencies having jurisdiction over or an interest in the area of the proposed operations that a complete plan is available for public review for this proposed operation.

The preparation plant and loadout facility is located just east of and adjacent to Consolidation's existing Emery Deep Mine which is approximately four miles south of the town of Emery, Utah, and two miles east of Highway 10. The legal boundaries of surface land affected include Township 22 South, Range 6 East, Section 32 N1/2 and Section 33 NW1/4 of N1/2. The proposed facility is shown on a Walker Flat, U. S. Geological Survey 7.5 minute quadrangle map.

The total surface disturbance of this facility is 210 acres.

The Division of Oil, Gas and Mining will proceed with a technical analysis (TA) to determine whether the proposed plan meets all the criteria of the Permanent Program Performance Standards according to the requirements of UCA, Section 40-10-1 et seq.

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Upon completion of the TA for said plan, a decision will be made as to approval or disapproval of the permit application. No decision will be taken by the Director for a minimum period of 30 days after submission of this Notice of Availability to the appropriate agencies.

This plan is available for public review at the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining, 4241 State Office Building, Salt Lake City, Utah 84114, and at the Recorder's Office, Carbon County Courthouse, Price, Utah 84501.
